


Internship as an academic course



An 'internship course' is *more* than just an internship

- Do everything you would normally do at an internship
- But also leverage your position to reflect, apply, and create knowledge!
- Solve a challenge for the company that you are working for!

Top tip: Think of yourself as an intern *and* a consultant







Requirements





- 1. A *qualified* position where you can deepen your competences
- 2. A position *relevant* to your programme
- 3. At least 200 hours of internship
 - 15 hp = Minimum ten weeks fulltime (or equivalent)
 - 7.5 hp = Minimum five weeks fulltime (or equivalent)

Application process

Meet with your study counsellor to see if you are eligible for doing an internship course

Find an internship position (societalengagement@ju.se)

Check if the course fits in your programme (study counsellor)

Get internship approved (2 forms – links can be found on the Canvas page of your program)

- Find an internship
- Get the organization to
 - assign a contact person
 - write you an official acceptance letter (can also just be an email)

 Receive a confirmation email

- Fill in the application form and score
 100% in the quiz
- Ask the company to fill in the company registration form.
- Madeleine will add you to the Canvas page and send an email to you (CC study counsellor) and the company (please note this means your internship has been accepted).
- Do not forget to register for the course on LADOK

Contact your student counsellor <u>before</u> the deadline to express your interest in the internship course

Students who have not expressed their interest in the course before the deadline will not be considered for registration



Hand-ins: 4+1





During the internship: Four field-note reflections

- Each hand-in should contain three reflections based upon your experiences (interpretations, insights, critiques, ...)
- Evenly spaced throughout the internship. Submit on Canvas
- One-three pages each
- Missing reflections or untimely submission will result in an alternative assignment

After the internship: A business report

- Solve a challenge for your host company
- Professional document, similar to reports from KPMG, BCG, McKinsey, Deloitte...
- Minimum 10 academic sources
- Submit on the Canvas page within four weeks of the last day of your internship

Reflections and internship report are graded either **pass** or **fail**More information can be found in the study guide (see Canvas)



Business report structure



2000 instead of 4000 words!

Introduction

- present the company and motivate the research question related to a company challenge or need.
- summarize the topic in focus during your internship

Fact check

• Fact check of previous and relevant research (based on the literature requirements)

Findings

- make suggestions on how to tackle the company challenge or need.
- Presentation of observations/experiences/discussions (etc) in practice combined with critical discussion and analyses (including references to previous research).

Conclusions and recommendations for practice

Don't forget academic references!




- 1. Search for literature on Scopus, Web of Science, GoogleScholar or at the university library platform
 - 1. Is it a journal article or a book?
 - 1. For journal articles: Check whether the article is in the ABS list i. The journal is not in the list: Do NOT include
 - 2. The journal is ranked 1 in the AJG2021 Column: Do NOT include
 - 3. The journal is ranked 2, 3, 4, or 4* in the AJG2021 Column: Include
 - For books: Check whether the publisher is one of those publishing houses: Springer, Elsevier, Wiley, Taylor & Francis, Cambridge University Press, Oxford University Press, Palgrave Macillan, Routledge, Sage Publications, Emerald Group Publishing IGI Global
 - 1. The book is not related to methodology: Do NOT include
 - 2. The book has not been published by one of the named publishing houses: Do NOT include
 - 3. The book has been published in one of these publishing houses and the content is related to methodology: Include
 - 3. Cite the references in APA style (I recommend using the freeware Mendeley)
 - 4. Mark the citations that you want to be counted as 'academic references'







